## Featured Advocacy Activity: First Responder Network Authority Heats Up APCO 2019

Each summer APCO International holds its annual conference to gather public safety professionals from across the country to learn about the current state of emergency communications nationwide. At this year's APCO 2019, the 85th Annual Conference and Expo in Baltimore, MD, the First Responder Network Authority (FirstNet Authority) is gearing up to host a full FirstNet-dedicated track, with a variety of panels related to the deployment of FirstNet. In its inaugural year, the FirstNet track features a Roadmap-focused keynote from Board Chairman Edward Horowitz on Tuesday August 13.

Throughout August 11-14, attendees of the FirstNet track can expect robust discussions on key topics such as FirstNet apps and devices, local control, data management, and rural deployment. To highlight FirstNet's continued growth nationwide, a "FirstNet in Action" panel will feature subscribers sharing their experience as FirstNet users from around the country.


The FirstNet track culminates with a FirstNet Authority Town Hall during which members of the leadership team will answer questions from the participants and engage in discussions on upcoming activities and initiatives for public safety-focused investment in the FirstNet network.


