## Featured Advocacy Activity: Roadmap unveiling charts course for future of FirstNet

The First Responder Network Authority (FirstNet Authority) marked a significant milestone by unveiling a Roadmap focused on the future of the FirstNet network. FirstNet Authority Board Chair Edward Horowitz <u>announced the Roadmap's release</u> at the APCO International Conference and Expo in Baltimore.

The Roadmap reflects feedback gathered from over 15,000 public safety representatives across the country. In more than 600 engagements, workshops, and summits with first responders and other public safety personnel nationwide, the FirstNet Authority identified six domains that represent the most essential communication capabilities and technologies for public safety over the next five years:

- Network Core: envisions the Core, which provides the essential intelligence for the functioning of the network, evolving to remain technologically current
- Coverage and Capacity: enables robust and ubiquitous access to the network
- **Situational Awareness:** envisions real-time access, collection, and distribution of critical information
- Voice Communications: envisions high-quality, reliable voice communications nationwide working seamlessly across analog and digital platforms
- Secure Information Exchange: envisions the ability to access, exchange, and manage data securely and conveniently within and across public safety agencies and jurisdictions
- User Experience: seeks to ensure interfaces are designed for specific public safety users'

#### operational challenges

The FirstNet Authority will continue to engage public safety in focused conversations around these domains to ensure that the Roadmap reflects public safety's needs and priorities.

As the Roadmap evolves, it will create new opportunities for public safety's input. The FirstNet Authority looks forward to working with public safety entities, government officials, our private sector partner, AT&T, and various other industry representatives on FirstNet's future.
