### FirstNet Authority holds Indiana LMR-LTE Interconnection Webinar

On June 24th, the First Responder Network Authority (FirstNet Authority) hosted a webinar with the State of Indiana to discuss the Indiana Land Mobile Radio (LMR)-Long Term Evolution (LTE) Integration Project and FirstNet's Push-to-Talk program. FirstNet Authority Senior Public Safety Advisor John Hunt moderated the event that attracted close to 200 participants from 38 states and territories.

In their welcoming remarks, FirstNet Authority Chief Executive Officer Edward Parkinson and Executive Director of Public Safety Advocacy David Buchanan recognized the Indiana Integrated Public Safety Commission (IPSC) for being at the forefront of delivering LMR-LTE integration to improve public safety operations for first responders.

Kelly Dignin, Indiana IPSC Executive Director, discussed the IPSC's experience of connecting the state's LMR system with FirstNet to enhance coverage, provide redundancy to the statewide radio system, and expand capabilities for the state's first responders. She also noted the significant cost savings with the success of this project. Using schools and firegrounds as examples, Kelly detailed scenarios that demonstrated how integrated LMR-LTE systems connected to WiFi can extend coverage areas and enhance safety for Indiana's first responders.

Amy Haukeness, FirstNet Authority Senior Public Safety Product Advisor, updated the audience about the progress of the FirstNet Push-to-Talk (PTT) product. Initially

emphasized that FirstNet PTT is designed to augment and not to replace existing LMR systems. As FirstNet PTT continues to evolve and mature, the FirstNet Authority will stay in close contact with early adopters to learn from their experience.

After taking questions from the audience, John wrapped up the session by thanking the IPSC for sharing their integration experience. FirstNet Authority thanks all those who helped plan and attend the virtual event.

## The First Responder Network Authority Technology Domain: User Experience

Last year, the FirstNet Authority developed the FirstNet Roadmap with input from public safety, industry, government, and its partner AT&T to guide the growth and evolution of FirstNet over the next five years. Using feedback from more than 600 engagements, the FirstNet Authority gained a better understanding of public safety's operational needs and technology uses for mobile broadband communications. This input helped us to identify public safety's most important network capabilities and served as the basis for the Roadmap's six technology domains, including the User Experience domain.
