#### FirstNet Authority hosts second in webinar series for Connecticut

Last week, the FirstNet Authority hosted the second of four webinars included in the Connecticut FirstNet Summit Webinar Series. Opening remarks by Connecticut State Emergency Management Director and FirstNet Single Point of Contact **William Hackett** included an overview of the summit agenda focused on the 2020 Roadmap release and its situational awareness domain, of interest to **Connecticut's** public safety community.

#### Highlights included:

- The **FirstNet Authority Roadmap's** recent update, especially in the area of operationalizing situational awareness, benefits local agencies like the Connecticut State Operations Center. William and his team have relied on the FirstNet network's broadband **situational awareness** tools for access to essential, real-time information to help inform decisions, maintain preparedness, and support communications and operations during tropical storms, tornados, and a heavy winter storm on Christmas Eve.
- The **FirstNet App Catalog** continues to grow. For example, Intrepid Networks' Response for FirstNet® is one of many FirstNet-approved situational awareness apps that aggregate and synthesize information from multiple sources to create a common operating picture.
- As part of the 2020 Roadmap, the FirstNet Authority is actively collaborating with industry on technology engagements for public safety, such as location-based technologies. "The FirstNet Authority participated in a nearly three-month engagement with Intrepid [Networks]. The focus on this engagement was to work on their application, provide feedback, and suggest engagements for the product," explained Senior Public Safety Advisor **Bruce Fitzgerald**.
- FirstNet users are relying on the network's seamless connection to enhance situational awareness via video, voice, text, and essential online resources. For instance, during a gas outage in **Newport County**, **Rhode Island**, the Rhode Island Emergency Management Agency requested Wi-Fi hotspots and ruggedized devices loaded with geographic information system mapping software to help conduct wellness checks on the residents without heat. Additionally, after the pandemic hit, the **City of Alexandria in Virginia** relied on FirstNet and the network's hotspots and smartphones to power 9-1-1 call-taking and handle Computer Aided Dispatch operations remotely.

The **FirstNet Authority** is actively working with federal, state, and local public safety in the Nashville and southeast region to enhance our understanding of the service outage's impact on public safety communications and operations.

## **Connecting Wildland Firefighters with FirstNet**

When a wildfire broke out near Glenwood, Washington, first responders quickly discovered the remote area had nearly no cell service. Needing to communicate with one another as well as check weather reports and order additional supplies, the incident management team requested a **FirstNet deployable asset**. Within hours, the firefighters were connected with the situational awareness they needed.



# After the Flood - FirstNet Supports Michigan Responders

When heavy rain caused two dams to breach in Midland, Michigan, over 10,000 residents were forced to evacuate their homes. The Midland Fire Department requested statewide assistance, and the Oakland Communications Support Team answered the call. Using a **FirstNet deployable and devices**, first responders were able to access forms, maps, and other key information as they conducted damage assessment and cleanup.



### FirstNet Network Advances Public Safety Communications

First responders in **Pennsylvania**, **Idaho**, **Montana**, **Virginia**, and **Kansas** are getting a major boost in their wireless communications with the addition of new, purpose-built FirstNet cell sites. This new infrastructure is a part of the FirstNet network expansion that is bringing increased coverage, capacity, and capabilities for public safety.


